

As we say goodbye to summer, we definitely welcome fall and the glorious weather it brings. As the leaves start to turn, the golf course is in the best shape of the year. Some good news to report for the Club, the membership continues to grow. To date, we have brought in 95 new members for a net gain of 30 more members to our family at FHCC! The increase in



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membership has kept our pool busy, restaurant sales up, and our rounds of golf through the roof!

Even during the pandemic, we have made strides to improve our amenities including: curbside service in the dining room, new furniture at the pool, and most recently, resurfacing the tennis court with the addition of pickleball. Pickleball is one of the fastest growing sports in the world. Many of our snowbirds play when they head to Florida and Arizona for the winter but FHCC wanted to bring it to all of our members. Just visually improving the area was needed. The response and play happening on the courts is a huge bonus! During our Grand Opening Event, we had around 80 members of all ages come to check it out, listen to a free clinic, and watch a match between some local area pickleball pros (yes, there are pickleball professionals!). We are working to setup more lessons, clinics, and leagues for our members. We could not be more proud of all the hard work that went into making the updated courts possible. This was made possible by the capital improvement fund and many private donations. If you haven't played yet, give it a shot. It is a ton of fun!

We will be bringing back the employee bonus fund for our staff members. This is a \$20 fee that is applied to everyone's accounts on November 1st.* FHCC employees are our family and we want to make sure they get a bonus for the Holidays, especially this year during the pandemic.
