Additional updates planned include:

- new light fixtures in the dining room

Some of this will be completed after we reopen due to delays in receiving the products . The new entry way furniture will be coming in the next few weeks. Furniture for the dining room and card room has been back ordered due to COVID and we are waiting on a sample before we order the rest. Although we knew getting everything done in just two weeks was the goal, COVID delays are just part of the new normal right now. We appreciate the patience as we finish the entire project.

Another thing to look forward to is our new golf carts. Arriving sometime mid March to early April will be our new Lithium Battery Club Car Golf Carts. These new carts will be a much needed upgrade to our fleet. The increase from 24 Club owned carts to 30 will also help with availability. Lithium battery carts are 300lbs lighter and require much less maintenance and charge time than acid batteries. They hold their charge longer and the batteries themselves have 90% life after 8 years compared to acid batteries that wear down in year 4.

Don't forget that we are still running our 15 for 12 membership special. If you have any friends that are interested in joining, now is the time! Bring them out and show them our great facility and all the upgrades we have done.

## **Credit Book**

## **Embedded Ball Rule**

There are quite a few questions each year on the embedded ball rule, especially in the wet spring months coming up. If you watched the golf coverage from Torrey Pines over the weekend, you saw this come up multiple times (including the eventual winner Patrick Reed). An embedded ball is when your golf ball has breaks the plane of the ground. You are entitled free relief in all areas except penalty areas and the sand. First, you should call over your playing competitors to help with the ruling. Second, mark you golf ball with a tee and gently pick it up to see if there is an indentation in the ground. Once it has been determined the ball was embedded, you may clean it, and then take a drop within one club length (not nearer the hole) from where it was embedded, dropping from knee height. If it was determined that it is ***not*** embedded, then you must replace the ball in the exact spot it was picked up without being cleaned. Hopefully understanding this rule will help you out on wet days in the future!
